

Cookie information

1. What is a cookie?

We use cookies on this website. A cookie is a simple, small file that contains pages of data of this website and stored by your browser on your computer's hard drive. The information stored therein can be sent back to our servers the next time you visit us.

2. Use of permanent cookies

With the help of a permanent cookie we can recognize you when you visit our website again. This means that the website can be set up specifically to your preferences. Also when you have given your permission for placing cookies, we can remember this by means of a cookie. This way you do not have to repeat your preferences, saving you time and making more pleasant use of our website. Persistent cookies can be deleted via your browser settings.

3. Use of session cookies

With the help of a session cookie we can see which parts of the website you have watched during this visit. This allows us to adapt our services as much as possible to the surfing behavior of our visitors. These cookies are automatically deleted as soon as you close your web browser.

4. Tracking cookies

With your permission, we will place a cookie on your equipment. This can be retrieved as soon as you receive a visit a website from our network. This allows us to find out that, besides our website, you can also visit the concerning other website(s) from our network. The resulting profile is not linked to your name, address, email address and so on, but only to match content to your profile, so that it is as relevant to you as possible.

5. Tracking cookies from our advertisers

With your permission, our advertisers place "tracking cookies" on your equipment. Using these cookies, they keep track of which pages you visit from their network, in order to build a profile of your online surfing behavior. This profile is partly built on the basis of comparable information that they obtained from your visit to get other websites out of their network. This profile will not be linked to your name, address, email address and such, as we know, but only serves to tailor advertisements to your profile so that they are be as relevant to you as possible.

6. **Google Analytics**

Through our website, a cookie is placed by the U.S. company Google, as part of the service. "Analytics". We use this service to keep track of how visitors use the website and reports. to get about this. Google may provide this information to third parties if Google is legally required to do so or to the extent that third parties process the information on behalf of Google. We have no influence on this. The Information that Google collects is anonymized as much as possible. Your IP address is emphatically not given. The information is transferred to and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Google adheres to the Privacy Shield principles and is affiliated with the Privacy Shield Program of the U.S. Department of Commerce. This means that there is an appropriate level of protection for the processing of any personal data.

7. **Social media**

Our website includes buttons to promote ("like") or share ("tweet") web pages on social networks. These buttons work by means of pieces of code, which come from the social media itself. By means of this code cookies are placed. We have no influence on this. Please read the privacy statement of the social media to understand what they do with your (personal) data, which they use through this website. The information they collect is made anonymous as much as possible. The information is transferred to and by Twitter, Facebook, Google+ and LinkedIn and stored on servers in the United States. LinkedIn, Twitter, Facebook and Google+ adhere to the Privacy Shield principles and are affiliated with the U.S. Department of Commerce Privacy Shield program.

8. **Right of inspection and correction or deletion of your data**

You have the right to request access to, correction of, or deletion of your data. See our contact page. In order to prevent abuse, we may ask you to identify yourself adequately. When it concerns access to personal data, linked to a cookie, you need a copy of the cookie in question to send along. You can find these in the settings of your browser.

10. **Removal of tracking cookies placed by third parties**

Some tracking cookies are placed by third parties who serve ads to you through our website. You can delete these cookies centrally via Your Online Choices, so that they do not reach a website of a third place.
